What does Phase 2 mean for Currituck ...

- The public may attend meetings of the Board of Commissioners and Advisory Boards.
- Beaches, public park open space, and walking trails are open to the public.
- Public restroom and beach access facilities are open and will be cleaned on a more frequent schedule.
- Public access to county offices will remain on an appointment-only basis.
- (Exception) The Permit
 Offices will be open as
 follows only for citizens to
 drop-off permit applications.
 (A) Mainland: Tues and
 Thurs, 8 am 5 pm; and (B)
 Corolla: Wed, 8 am 5 pm
- Plexiglas dividers have been installed at customer service counters to limit the spread of COVID-19
- All Senior Centers remain closed to the public/staff reachable by phone/email
